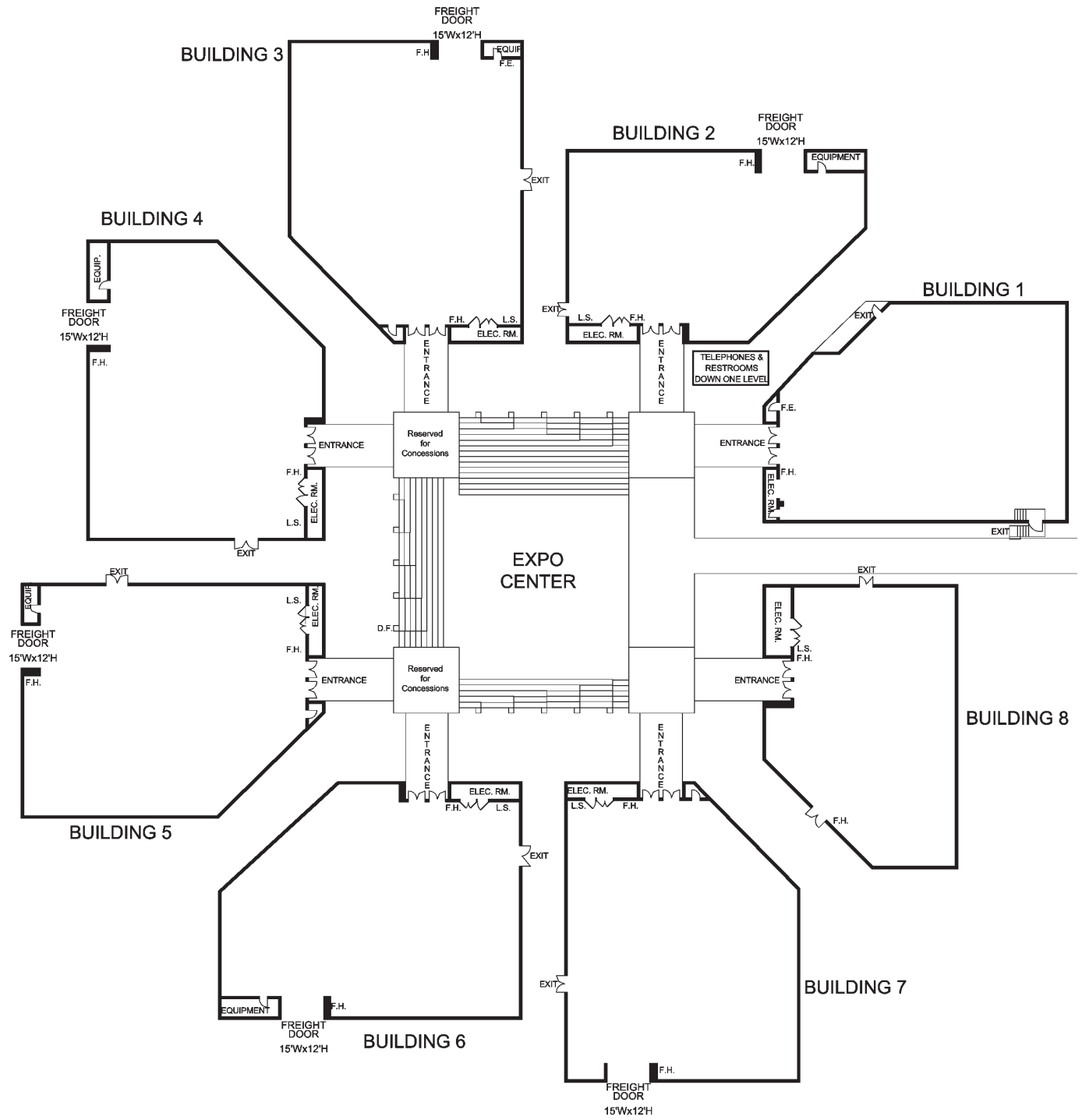

Expo Center

Expo Center is made up of eight buildings linked together by a common outdoor brick plaza. With a total of 58,870 square feet, this aesthetically pleasing complex includes a surrounding lagoon, dramatic entry bridge and finished white walls and floors in all the buildings. The clean lines and high ceilings are perfectly suited for car shows, trade and consumer shows, art exhibits, fundraisers, banquets, meetings and conventions. Past events include Bridal Showcase, Festival de la Familia and the Import Car Show.

Loading access	Loading doors in buildings #2-7, 15' W x 12' H or 7' W doors in buildings #1-8
Loading capacity	150 lbs./sq. ft. on pedestrian walkways and mezzanine levels
Permanent concessions	The Cantina (a lagoon-side outdoor café)
Restrooms	Under building #2 at lagoon level
Special features	House sound in individual buildings or entire complex, public telephones, air conditioning and heating in each building, brick outdoor plaza with stair-step seating (can be used for entertainment or additional exhibit space)
Walls	All with white smooth finish with beige sound-absorbing panels at ceiling level
Ceiling	#1 = 28'9", #2-6 = 21'6" with open track ceilings for lighting, #7 = 20'3" with finished drop tile ceiling, #8 = 19'10" with finished drop tile ceiling
